
















(1) 0107624 Swivel VESA Monitor Mount





### Install glides or casters


### <u>Glides</u>

- Install (2) glides in each foot. Adjustments can be made later if necessary for uneven floors.
- 2. Repeat on second foot.



#### **Casters**


- Install casters as shown. Note the non-locking caster installs on the end of the foot with holes.
- 2. Tighten securely.
- 3. Repeat on second foot.




### Attach foot assembly to desk

### **Glides**

- Carefully tip the desk assembly onto the audience-side to access the bottom.
- 2. Attach the inner foot bracket as shown with (4) 8-32 x 1/2" PH Thrd ctg screws. Do not tighten screws yet.
- Attach the outer foot bracket as shown with (3) 1/4-20 x 20mm JC bolts. Do not tighten screws yet.
- 4. Repeat on other foot.




- 5. Attach foot assembly with (3) 1/4-20 x 40mm JC bolts.
- 6. Tighten all screws.
- 7. Repeat on other foot.
- 8. Tip desk upright when complete.




#### **Casters**

- Carefully tip the desk assembly onto the audience-side to access the bottom.
- 2. Attach the foot assembly with (3) 1/4-20 x 40mm JC bolts.
- 3. Repeat on other foot.




## 3 Attach CPU tray

- Set the CPU tray into the opening in the desk and align the (4) mounting holes.
- Secure the tray with (4) 8-32 x 1/2" PH Thrd ctg screws and tighten securely.



### 4 Remove storage tray

- 1. Open desk lid.
- 2. Loosen the (2) storage tray mounting screws.
- 3. Push the tray back to unlock the keyholes and lift out.





### 5 Attach arms to desk

- 1. Orient the left and right arms as shown with the flanges facing inward.
- 2. Secure each arm with (4) 1/4-20 x 20mm JC bolts and tighten securely.
- 3. Replace storage tray from step 4.

## 6 Attach worksurface


- 1. Set the worksurface onto the arms and align the mounting holes.
- 2. Attach with (8) #14 x 7/8" PHSM, but do not overtighten.






### Keyboard storage

The keyboard storage brackets store the keyboard under the monitor and can be adjusted left and right to support most keyboards. The keyboard should rest in the brackets without interference with the monitor, worksurface, or column. If bracket adjustment is necessary, remove the (2) mounting screws to relocate the bracket to another mounting hole along the rail, then retighten.




### Removing audience-side panel


- The panel is designed for easy removal using keyhole slots and 1/4-20 JC bolts. If the bolts are tight, loosen slightly with a 4mm hex wrench.
- 2. Remove the (2) upper JC bolts and lift up on panel to unlock from the keyhole slots.
- 2. Lift off the panel.




### Monitor installation

 Attach the VESA mount (butterfly-shaped portion) to the back of your flat panel monitor with (4) M4 x 12mm PHM screws (not included). (Holes on top, slots on bottom). Note: It will be necessary to remove the standard base that comes with the monitor to use the VESA mount.






- Slide the monitor assembly to the left making leaving at least a 1/4" gap between the monitor and lift column.
- 5. Tighten all (4) 10-24 SHC screws to secure.





### Cord management

- 1. With the back panel removed, connect the necessary monitor, keyboard, and mouse cords above the worksurface.
- 2. Use the wire loom attached to the back of the keyboard tray to route wire and cables down to the bottom of the desk. The wire loom keeps cords together and protects them while the monitor is being raised and lowered. To access the wire loom use a flat head screwdriver to pry open and release each loom clip
- 3. Route wires and cords down through the loom.
- 4. Be sure to provide enough slack in the cords during normal use and for left / right mouse locations.

Top View









### Optional power module installation


- To install an optional power module, loosen the (2) keyhole screws securing the storage tray.
- 2. Lift the storage tray out of the desk.




- 5. Feed the power cord and power module into the tray opening.
- Replace the flanges on the power module and tighten to secure the power module to the tray.



- 3. Remove the screws and cover plate from the storage tray.
- 4. Remove the (2) clamp flanges from the power module. (Not shown).




- Set the storage tray assembly back into the desk opening and lock into the (2) keyholes.
- 8. Re-tighten the keyhole mounting screws.




#### Maintenance

After approximately 300 cycles of opening and closing, the friction dampener on the worksurface lid should be retightened to 13 in-lb using a torque wrench with a 4mm hex driver. If a torque wrench is unavailable, tighten the friction damper with a 4mm hex wrench 1/8 turn at a time and test. The correct adjustment is when the lid slows down between 2-4" from closure.


